About Diploma Course on Community Development Management:

Share and Care Nepal is a registered organization working primarily for the upliftment of the neediest people in remote and urban areas of Nepal. Over the past 26 years, SCN has been involved in conducting various short term courses for its community, partners, staff as well as international volunteers/students. While serving the communities as enablers and facilitators, we have learned many practical aspects of community development and management. There were requests from individuals and organizations as well as local churches to formalize our short term training programs. In response to these requests, SCN designed a Diploma Course in Community Development Management. It is expected that the capacity of individuals, organizations, and Churches will be strengthened in community development initiatives. We would also like to encourage and inspire the process of adopting the best development practices by all involved in community development.

Purpose of the Course

The course is aimed at equipping the community development workers with adequate knowledge and skill in community development. The theoretical knowledge and practical experience gained by the participants will enhance their professional competence for the effective implementation of the community development programs.

Duration of the Course

The duration of the training will be for one year. The entire training is divided into three phases; Residential, Online/Web-Based Learning & Community Lab/Field Based Application. In the first phase, web-based online participants will be sending the information, documents, and assignments about the course for four months and in the case of participants who did not access web-based facilities, reading materials and assignments will be sent by postal service. In the second phase, the participant will attend a residential course for five weeks. In the third phase, the participants will go back to their respective organizations who have sponsored them, for four months. During which SCN would follow up with participants as they implement their learning in their projects. They also apply their learning gained during the residential. Their learning will be monitored and support will be offered to them through visits or other means. On successful completion of the course, the participants will be awarded a diploma certificate.

Learning Methodologies

Various adult learning tools will be used to facilitate learning. The online learning would include the reading materials and assignments through web base online and postal service. The residential learning would include lectures, group discussions, participants' interaction with each other and assignments, experience sharing from experts, and designing a project. The participants will be encouraged to make use of the resource material. The field-based learning would include opportunities to observe the practical implementation of community development concepts. The community-based resource persons would share their practical experiences. For experiential learning, the participants will be given field assignments to apply the new knowledge in the communities.

Who will benefit from the Course?

Those program and management staff of organizations, who are working with rural/urban communities and who have the desire to facilitate community development activities but lack the perspective, in-depth knowledge, and skills will benefit from the program.

Field Learning Plan

Language use for the Course

The course will be held in the Nepali language with reference materials in both Nepali and English language.

Resource Person and Faculty

Resource persons will be selected from among those that are academically qualified with rich practical experience in community development. There will be three categories of resource persons i.e. 1. Field base resource person, who have first-hand practical knowledge on the communities, 2. Internal resource persons, who are involved in the design of the course and also have the hands-on skills, 3. The outside expertise resource person, who has the knowledge based on the subject expertise nationally and internationally. The mixture of prospective knowledge, skills, and field practicability would enable the participants to get conceptual knowledge, tested skills, and application in real situations.

Entry Requirements:

The entry requirement for the course would be:

- 1. Higher secondary education passed with at least 2 years of working experience in community development.
- 2. Age 20 35 yeas
- 3. Priority will be given to the candidates from rural areas, ethnic and Dalit communities.
- 4. Sponsored by an organization, CBOs, or a Church
